"Black on White on Black on White" is the name given by Segel for this composition. The subject is open to interpretation though some viewers could think a symbol for the good and the bad or the Yin and the Yang? It sits in a simple black wood frame. David Segel is an internationally acclaimed and respected artist. After studying at the Carnegie Institute in Pittsburgh, and the Art Institute of Chicago, David moved to Paris in 1950 to work and teach, He studied in the atelier of Fernand Leger and then travelled around other Western European countries. He has been shown in galleries from Paris, France, to Los Angeles, California, including the Whitney Museum in New York City. Segel enjoyed a prolific career and worked with a variety of mediums including oils, bronze and wood sculptures, and dramatic sketches. Segel's work is represented in the permanent collection of the Whitney Museum. His awards include The First Carnegie Prise and The Hallmark International Art Award. David Segel died in Venice, California in 2005 at the age of 84.
