Fine-colour lithograph depicting a guitar, a vase, an ace of hearts, and two gaming dice. It is numbered 235 of 275 copies and signed by the artist Tony Agostini.

Tony Agostini was part of The School of Paris. This term does not refer to a single art movement or institution, but rather Paris' prominence as a hub of creative exploration in the early decades of the 20th century. For this work, Agostini deviates from traditional approaches, emphasising not only the representation of individual objects but also their integration into a harmonious mosaic. The choice of colours and their fragmented assemblages into defined forms contributes to the aesthetic of the overall visual. The palette chosen by Agostini ranges from delicate pinks to rich burgundies, with vibrant oranges in between. These colours are delineated by lighter ink, offering a glimpse into the

Tony Agostini, born in 1916 Antoine Sylvestre Agostini, was a French painter and lithographer. He died in 1990. In the early stages of his career, he painted the people, squares, and streets of Paris before moving on to landscapes, studio interiors, and, more essentially, still life, which was a major theme in his lithographic work.
