Context and Legacy

Makio Hasuike, a Japanese-born designer based in Milan, was one of the pioneers of industrial design in Italy. His collaborations with Gedy, a company renowned for its innovative bathroom and vanity accessories, helped redefine modern domestic design in the 1960s and 1970s. Hasuike's creations for Gedy—practical yet elegant—reflect a fascination with modularity and circular geometry, anticipating the clean lines and bold forms of contemporary minimalism.
